National Association for Spina Bifida

On the 30th December I sent you a copy of a letter I received from the Board of Trade regarding the above proposed Company, in which I expect you noticed that it was stated that a further letter would be sent regarding the name.

I have now heard from the Registrar of Companies that he is not prepared to allow the word "National" to appear in the title of the Company at this stage. It seems that for this word to be allowed it must be shown that the proposed Company not only is genuinely Nation wide but also has acquired reputation and standing. The Registrar has, therefore, only approved the name "Association for Spina Bifida and Hydrocephalus Limited". I presume you are agreeable to my proceeding on this basis.
